

Professional and Ethical Behavior

Professional and Ethical Behavior is required of all MSAT students. Specifically, MSAT students must comply with the National Athletic Trainers Association Code of Ethics, clinical site policies and procedures, and confidentiality agreements. In addition, students are expected to maintain the highest levels of professionalism, including appearance, punctuality, and demeanor. Students should also consult the Augustana University Student Handbook and the University catalog for policies relating to possession of alcoholic beverages/use of illegal drugs. In addition, students have a continual obligation to report any criminal felony or misdemeanor (including drug and/or alcohol) charges pending against him/her. Any violations of professional or ethical behavior will result in dismissal from clinical laboratory and disciplinary action in accordance with University policies. At the discretion of the Master of Science in Athletic Training Program Director, this may also include additional penalties and/or dismissal from the Master of Science in Athletic Training Program.
