Aut	hority:
•	Does the author have credentials and/or valid experience related to the topic? Are the author's organizational affiliations given? If yes, are they appropriate? (Does the URL reveal anything about the author or source?) What are the author's qualifications to write about the topic? Is there contact information, such as a publisher or email address?
Bias	/Balance:
•	Do they have a political, religious, ideological, cultural, or institutional agenda? Do they mention sponsorships or funding?
Curr	ency:
•	When was the information published or posted? Has it been revised or updated? Is the information (or links) current or out of date for your topic?
Doc	umentation:
•	Is the evidence cited or referenced in some way? Is there a list of sources?
•	Are the sources listed current? Are they credible?
