# **Kay Armstrong Memorial Scholarship**

Awarded to students graduating from Delta County High Schools who have been active in community service and have maintained a 3.0 GPA. One of the candidates chosen must be an aspiring teacher. These \$1,000 scholarships are renewable.

#### Caddo Scholarship

Awarded to graduating seniors from the Western Slope high schools with preference given to students from Delta County Schools. Must plan to attend Colorado School of Mines to be eligible. Up to three scholarships will be awarded. These \$5,000 scholarships may or may not be renewable for a second year.

## Colorado Opportunity Scholarship (COSI)

This grant provides scholarships to residents of Delta County demonstrating financial need who are: a) currently juniors or seniors attending a high school in Delta County, participating in concurrent enrollment with Technical College of the Rockies (TCR) or planning to attend TCR after graduation; b) are currently attending TCR or have applied and been accepted to TCR for an upcoming program. For more information about whether you qualify for COSI, please talk to your high school counselor, or the financial aid department at TCR.

# **Edith May Cox Scholarship**

Awarded to a student graduating from a Delta County high school who has significant musical talent. This \$1,000 scholarship is renewable. **Please Note: This scholarship will not be awarded until further notice.** 

### **Dorothy Crousen Scholarship**

Awarded to a student graduating from a Delta County high school who has a solid academic record, financial need, and has musical/artistic talent. This \$500 scholarship is non-renewable.

#### **Weldon Crousen Scholarship**

Awarded to a student graduating from a Delta County high school who has a solid academic record, financial need, and exemplifies good citizenship. This \$500 scholarship is non-renewable.

#### **Delta County High School General Scholarship**

Awarded to a student graduating from a Delta County high school. This \$1,000 scholarship is non-renewable.

#### **Didrickson-Niles Scholarship**

Awarded to students graduating from a Delta County high school. These \$1,000 scholarships are non-renewable.

#### **Lew Goodhart Memorial Scholarship**

Awarded to students who have completed some college credit hours and are legal residents of the State of Colorado. Preference will be given to non-traditional students, defined as adult students or a re-entry student. The students must have a GPA in the 2.0-3.5 range and must demonstrate financial need. Enrollment in a Colorado educational facility is required. Preference will be given to residents of Colorado's western slope who are attending a western slope institution of higher education. These \$1,000 scholarships may be renewable.

#### Nick and Linda Hattel Scholarship

Awarded to students graduating from Delta High School with a minimum GPA of 2.75 who have financial need and demonstrate good character and work ethic. Recipients should have realistic plan for their careers and be able to articulate why they want to pursue an advanced degree or acquire a vocational training certificate. Students must attend an accredited secular university, college, or vocational program in the state of Colorado. These \$2,000 scholarships are non-renewable.

#### Leitzinger-Hallenbeck Scholarship

Awarded to a student graduating from North Fork High School, with a 3.0 GPA or better. This \$500 scholarship is renewable.

# **Maltese Cross Scholarship**

Awarded to active Fire Fighters who are members of a fire department in Delta, Garfield, Mesa, Moffat, Montrose, Ouray or Rio Blanco; who are working towards an Associates, Bachelors or Masters (or certification) in Fire Science, Public Administration, Public Safety or related course; who maintain a GPA 3.0 or higher; who attend a regionally accredited traditional or on-line college or university; and who have enrolled in at least 3 credits each semester. These \$2,000 scholarships are renewable.

#### Richard W. McGuire Jr. Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to students graduating from Delta County high schools with a preference given to graduates of Cedaredge High School. Must plan to study a field of natural science (biology, chemistry, botany, physics, medicine, nutrition, health, etc.) and attend a school in Colorado. These \$1,000 – \$2,000 scholarships are renewable.

#### **David Moore Scholarship**

Awarded to graduating seniors from Delta County high schools who have participated in vocal or instrumental music programs in their high school for at least three years, which must include their senior year. Up to four \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded. These scholarships are non-renewable.

### **Lena Sammons Reed Scholarship**

Awarded to graduating seniors of North Fork High School, renewing recipients of this scholarship, and past Hotchkiss High School graduates applying for the first time, including non-traditional students and students working on advanced degrees. All applicants must have attended Crawford Elementary School for two complete years prior to June 1, 2014. Must have a minimum GPA of 2.0. These scholarships are renewable.

#### Stanway Scholarship

Awarded to a graduating senior from North Fork High School. This \$1,000 scholarship is non-renewable.

#### Stewart/Watson/Wheeler Scholarship

Awarded to students graduating from Delta County School District and Mancos School District with a B+ average (3.3 GPA). Those applying need to have a desire to better themselves, improve their knowledge, learn a trade or profession, and provide for themselves and/or family. These \$1,000 scholarships are non-renewable.

#### **Kittie Udd Memorial Scholarship**

Awarded to graduating seniors from Cedaredge High School studying in the field of Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math. Student must maintain a B average. These \$1,000 scholarships are renewable.

#### Jeanette Wilkinson Scholarship

Awarded to students graduating from Delta High School. These \$1,000 scholarships are non-renewable.

#### **Willson Education Scholarship**

Awarded to students graduating from Mesa and Delta County public high schools. Funds can be used at any not-for-profit two- or four-year college or university or vocational institution. Financial need is a consideration. The amount of the funding will vary depending on each recipient's individual circumstances. These scholarships are renewable.
