Six teams of worshipers served as the hands and feet of Jesus by visiting the sick and elderly, picking up litter, preparing care packages for women living at the Salvation Army, giving gifts and writing letters to the Police Department, and helping clean a church member's house. This is the kind of community outreach we envision taking place through our church in the coming months and years ahead. community meals, a Financial Peace University outreach ministry, adult book studies, and small discipleship groups.


