- Student Supervision will begin at 8:05 am each morning and the doors to the building will open at 8:10.
- In an effort to get children into the building in a timely manner, playground equipment will not be utilized prior to school. Once students arrive (8:05-8:15), they will wait 3 feet apart at their grade level doors.
- Students will be able to enter the building and go directly to their classrooms. They will be able to begin entering at 8:10 am.
- Students will need to be wearing their face masks upon entry to the building.
- The classroom teachers will be in the rooms ready to greet their students and provide a squirt of sanitizer to each child.
- The second bell will ring at 8:15. This is when the supervisors will close the
 doors and go back into the building. If your child arrives after 8:15,
 he/she will need to go to Door #1 (front entrance) to check in with the
 office staff.

Your child will enter through his/her assigned grade level door each morning. **SEE MAP

WE ASK THAT FAMILIES DO NOT CONGREGATE IN GROUPS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS AND KEEP 3 FEET APART FROM OTHER FAMILIES.

Phone/Wearable Technology Use

While a student can bring their electronic device (including cell phones and AirPods) to school, all non-district-issued technologies are to be silenced and out of sight throughout the school day. Students are allowed to wear smartwatches, but they are to be silenced during the school day. The district-provided technology will be utilized for students to participate in lessons and complete assignments.
