DCC High School Information (Virtual) Session Lottery (choice) and Academy Presentation September 2024

1. What is the Downcounty Consortium?

The Downcounty Consortium is comprised of five high schools for students who live in the DCC attendance area or attend a DCC middle school. The five high schools include Montgomery Blair, Albert Einstein, John F. Kennedy, Northwood, and Wheaton High Schools. Current Grade 8 students who live in the DCC or attend a DCC middle school are eligible to be assigned to a DCC high school. Students who reside in the area MUST submit a Choice form to be assigned to a high school for the following school year.

3. What is the choice process timeline?

- September/October
- Virtual Information Session
- o DCC Choice lesson at DCC middle schools
- Open Houses at all five DCC high schools (see high school's home page the night of the event to view the event)
- o *Choice* form submission instructions mailed to students' homes (mid-October)
- DCC private/non-MCPS students pre-enrollment process email <u>DCCAPS@mcpsmd.org</u> to begin the process
- November
 - o Round 1 Choice Form submission deadline-November 1, 2024
- January
- o High school assignment letters mailed to students' homes in late January
- February
 - Students register for high school courses



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

4. When will the choice form link become available?

The choice form link will become available once instructions are mailed to DCC MCPS residing students in mid-October. The student's MCPS google account will be needed to access the form.

Private school families will be provided a choice form once the pre-registration process is complete and all registration documents have been received.

5. What do all of the DCC high schools have in common?

All schools have a comprehensive program, interesting and challenging coursework, honors and Advanced Placement (AP) classes, special education and ELD programs, partnerships with universities, colleges, businesses, and internships.

6. What is an academy program?

A sequence of related courses designed around a central theme, a program of study that helps students make meaningful connections between their academics and their personal interests and make plans for post-high school and future careers

7. What is a student's base high school?

Base high school is determined by a student's home address. To determine a student's base high school, visit: http://gis.mcpsmd.org/SchoolAssignmentTool2/Index.xhtml. Assignment to the base high school is guaranteed if selected 1st on *Choice* form or selected as 2nd choice if the 1st choice school is unavailable

8. What is Round 2 and who is eligible to participate?

Round 2 is the second opportunity for students and parents to participate in the *Choice* process, for the upcoming school year. Round 2 is available to students who did not get their first choice in Round 1, students on transfer within the DCC, and new students to the DCC area.

9. How can I participate in Round 2?

If you did not get your first choice in Round 1, you can complete a "Resubmit Form" on-line requesting participation in Round 2. Original choices will be re-entered. Re-entry of choices does not guarantee first choice in Round 2. Choices may NOT be changed from Round 1 to Round 2. If you are a new student to the DCC area since the Round 1 deadline, you can submit a completed Choice form using your student google account by the deadline for Round 2 which is Feb. 7, 2025.

10. How do students who live outside the DCC but attend a DCC middle school participate in DCC Choice?

Transfer students have the option to participate in Round 2 of the lottery which occurs in early February. They will receive choice form submission instructions in the mail in mid-January. Round 2 forms need to be submitted by Feb. 7, 2025 and Round 2 assignment letters are mailed out in March.

11. Do students who apply to an interest or criteria-based application only program still need to complete a lottery *choice* form?

Yes. The application process is a completely different process from the lottery *Choice* process.

12. If I am assigned a DCC or NEC school and I move within the DCC or NEC, can I change schools?

Student reassignment in the consortium occurs only through the Change of Choice process (lottery/Round 2) or through an appeal. Students who move within the consortium stay at their assigned school as bus transportation for students 2 miles or more from assigned school is provided.
