## Introduction:

You have just been asked to participate in the development of a WWII museum. The theme of the museum is "The War At Home" and the specific purpose is explore how different racial, ethnic, and gender groups contributed to the war and were affected by the war.

Your job is to contribute to the museum by designing an exhibit that focuses one of above groups. The design would include:

- 1. A narrative explaining what your exhibit is going to communicate to the visitors. In other words, write a brief explanation that tells the visitors what they will experience and learn. Also add a clear connection between the museum's theme and your specific exhibit.
- 2. Artifacts (objects) that were used by the group or represent the treatment of the group.
- 3. Documents, maps, drawings, pieces of art, photos from the time period.
- 4. An interactive activity that helps the visitors understand the group's experiences.
- 5. Film clips.
