If you choose to design your own ad apart from the templates provided, simply choose a blank template and upload your ad onto the template. Submissions are due **NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 22ND!**

IMPORTANT NOTE: All deadlines are final! No exceptions. We are on hard deadlines with Herff Jones.

How to create to senior ad:

Before you begin, make sure you have digital copies of your pictures on your device.

1. Go to <https://www.yearbookordercenter.com/index.cfm/job/897>
2. Click continue
3. Click on "Start your ad."
4. Select which size senior ad size you would like to purchase (full, half, quarter).
5. Add your student's information and click on "add new student." Click "next" on the right bottom of the page.
6. Create an account: enter your name, email address, and create a password (press create account when finished).
7. Select a template.
8. Now you are at the digital studio where you have the option to choose background, student name, message, and photos. Click on each one to edit. When you upload your photos, note if a photo does not have a high enough resolution (300 dpi) it will give you a warning message. If you still choose to use this photo, it may not come out clear once it's printed.
9. Once you have created an ad, select continue. You will have the option to "edit ad," "finish later," or "add to cart." When you add to cart, you will pay for your ad online, and we will be sent a notification that your ad is ready to go!
