Position Description

The Sustainability Office is seeking two student managers to oversee the ReCoop spring collection, fall sale, and 20-30 ReCoop Crew student members. Applicants should demonstrate high levels of responsibility, organization, communication, and a can-do attitude. Managers will be responsible for communicating with the ReCoop Crew, setting up donation locations, overseeing the collection process, assisting crew members with collection, and hosting the sale. The position pays \$17/hour. Prior experience working or attending ReCoop is desired but not required.
