

Quick Steps for Canvas Studio

It's super easy to make videos (there's a good tutorial) and the closed captioning is relatively accurate (you can preview it and make edits as well).

I just posted a new video for one of my classes, and realized that there is something that might be confusing in terms of how to share it to your class.

When you want to share your video with a class (let's say in the week's module, which is how I always organize my classes) you'll click on the little + sign to add something to the Module (it's on the right side of your screen of the module). A dropbox will appear. Scroll down and select External Tool and then a new screen will pop up where you'll be able to select Canvas Studio. A list of your videos should then come up and you can select the one you want and then click on Embed, and then click "Add Item." In your Module you'll now see a link to Canvas Studio.

Of course, because it's Canvas, we're not finished yet. If you don't see the little green check mark on the right side of the screen next to the item, you have to publish it (highlight the circle with the line through it -- the word publish should come up, so click on the circle and you should see the green checkmark -- whenever you post something, it's a good idea to check that it's published).

Finally, you'll want to give the video a name. Next to the green check mark, click on the three dots and select edit. Under Title you can enter whatever name you want to give it and hit "Update."

If this doesn't make sense, just let me know -- Lisa and Michael I know use Studio as well and can chime in if I've missed something.
