Interpretive Cautions

Extreme caution should be used in interpreting data for small numbers (<100) of candidates, as such data may not provide a valid indication of how candidates typically perform. Results reported for only a small number of candidates may not be indicative of how large numbers of candidates typically perform.

Analysis: Oakland University has an overall pass rate of 83.1% for all the licensure tests. Oakland University seeks to support all students in the passing of licensure tests through tutoring, one-to-one faculty assistance, and providing resources. Twelve of OU's twenty-nine represented programs have a 90% or higher MTTC pass rate. OU is aware that there are programs with lower pass rates, and those programs are analyzed on an annual basis to ensure that the curriculum is aligned to the State of Michigan standards. For example, courses in the History program are offering more information in the area of World History and the Early Childhood (General and Special Education) program has engaged in work to add more special education components to their programs. All Elementary programs are updated, and the new Elementary programs for the PK-3 and 3-6 grade bands were implemented in the fall of 2021.
