





 - 1. Climate change enhances the spread of pests that causes life-threatening diseases like dengue, malaria, Lyme disease, etc.










Gender Issues

5. Only 46 countries have met the UN target of 30 percent female decision-makers.





1. 300,000 Palestinians in the West Bank and Gaza Strip became refugees during Israel's conquest in June 1967; the vast majority were unable to return.





3. Palestinians suffer from a discriminatory water policy maintained by Israeli authorities.









Below, I include some impressive analysis done by Linda Witong- Abrahm (lwitong@gmail.com) as a helpful example

'So, Susan and I saw that the term "foreign occupation" was used in paragraph #4 in the 6-27-2017 Ministerial document. If that is the clause they are having a problem with, they are out of luck as they already agreed to that exact paragraph as #7 in the 2016 Ministerial declaration...

e.g.

1 The Ministerial declaration of the 2016 high-level political forum on sustainable development, convened under the auspices of the Economic and Social Council, on the theme "Ensuring that no one is left behind" (E/HLS/2016/1)

Paragraph #7: "We call for further effective measures and actions to be taken, in conformity with international law, to remove the obstacles to the full realization of the right of self-determination of peoples living under colonial and foreign occupation, which continue to adversely affect their economic and social development as well as their environment"

2. Now look at the 6-27-17 Ministerial Draft:

Paragraph 4: "We call for further effective measures and actions to be taken, in conformity with international law, to remove the obstacles to the full realization of the right of self-determination of peoples living under colonial and foreign occupation, which continue to adversely affect their economic and social development as well as their environment";

It is the same language...I cannot find any other paragraph which uses foreign occupation in the 2017 draft

So, if they are objecting to that, we have to remind them that it was agreed to in 2016. If they did a reservation, it is already on record or they can do it again this year...'

This stuff really makes a difference everyone, so please follow through on this.
