What is gouache? Aside from having all the vowels except "i", gouache is basically a watercolor that is opaque instead of transparent. During this class, you will learn what you need to get started as well as basic techniques to get familiar with gouache. We'll go over mixing, wet-in-wet, wet on dry, dark on light and light on dark. We'll also cover gouache's limitations and some of the benefits of this medium. You will apply these techniques to get a feel of gouache's unique characteristics and leave with a finished piece that will have others exclaiming, "oh my gouache"! This is a fun beginners class open to all ages.

Gouache Paint

I prefer M.Graham & Co. The paint is made in Hubbard, Oregon, has vivid pigment, and is resistant to cracking.

- Phthalocyanine Blue (Primary)
- Hansa Yellow (Primary)
- Pyrrol Red (Primary)
- Titanium White
- Ivory Black

Brushes

For the most part. I use round, synthetic, watercolor brushes, not natural bristle ones.

- One small brush (1,2)
- One medium brush (5,6,7,)
- One large brush (10,11,12)

Content

Photograph or composition you would like to work on. I will provide a composition if you do not bring one.

Other

- Drawing pencil (optional)
- Kneaded Eraser (optional)
- 140lb cold press paper in a pad or block, any size
- Palette for mixing colors
- Paint rag
- Jar for water
