Tips:

- Apply for scholarships at the schools you plan to attend.
 - Narrow your list down to two or three schools, apply for scholarships on each school's website, and then compare your financial aid and scholarship packages (late spring/early summer) to determine which school is the best fit for you.
- Check for scholarship opportunities through any clubs or organizations that you or your parents belong to.
- Check for scholarship opportunities through your parent(s) workplace.
- The majority of scholarship applications require an essay(s) and a few may ask for a college resume.
- Create a folder on your desktop where you can save all of your essays. Once you have written an essay for a scholarship, make a copy and revise it for other essays. Save each essay under the scholarship's name. When you apply the following year(s), you can update and revise the essay.
- Check with your guidance counselor for additional scholarship opportunities. Your guidance counselor should be one of your BFFs during high school. Make sure to thank them for their help!!!
