Policy 370: CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMS

A variety of co-curricular activity programs in academic, athletic, and social areas shall be offered to students enrolled in the Oak Creek-Franklin public schools. Participation in co-curricular activities, including clubs, honor societies, intramurals, athletic teams, musical or dramatic performances, etc., shall be voluntary and in accordance with established school and activity rules. Students who violate school and/or activity rules shall be subject to disciplinary action.

Co-curricular activities are defined as activities occurring outside the school day that are connected to the skills and concepts students are learning in their classes and provide opportunities for students to expand or enhance their learning in any of the subject areas. The administration shall assign advisors of all school-sponsored co-curricular organizations and activities.

The Oak Creek-Franklin Board of Education supplies certain items of uniforms and equipment for participants in various school-sponsored athletics and activities. Any other items needed will be supplied by the participant and will be of a kind and quality acceptable to the respective coaches. School colors (blue and white) shall be significantly incorporated into all uniforms used for competition. Proposed uniforms must be approved by the Activities/Athletic Director.

Groups or activity programs that support student organizations or activities but are not school-sponsored programs with an assigned advisor or not under the direct control of the school or district must have their own tax identification number, their own exempt status, their own bank accounts (with group's name and tax ID number), and their own proof of insurability.
