

QAR Vocabulary

QAR – Question, Answer Relationship. This is a method that can be used to determine what type of question is being asked about a reading passage. Determining the question will help the student to know where to find the answer. There are four types of questions. Two are found directly in the text, and two are found in the reader's head.

Right There – these questions have only one answer and are found almost word for word in the text

Think and Search – these questions are found in more than one place in the text

Author and Me – these questions are answered by the reader, but use information found in the text as support

On My Own – these questions are answered completely by the student

text – a written passage. This may be narrative or informational, fiction or nonfiction
