Attendance Expectations

To be High School ready, all middle school students need to have an attendance percentage of 95% or higher.

This means students should not miss more than 5 days per school year.

Students who meet this goal will be celebrated at the end of the year Awards Assembly.



What does it mean to be tardy?

Tardy, by definition, means:

late; behind time; not on time

Why is it important to be on time?

If you are late to class, you are late to start learning.

Hamilton maximizes classroom learning time by ensuring that instruction starts on time!


Students have a 5 minute passing period between classes.

Accountability for Tardies

 Tardy sweep = 10 minute detention at lunch or after school

 5+ tardies in one week = 30 minute detention on Friday and parent contact



- Water Bottles are encouraged




School Boundaries




Lunch Boundaries

- Students should NOT be in buildings during lunch




Before School

WOLVERINE'S DEN EXPECTATIONS




- A brain break in the wellness center or counseling office is no more than 10 minutes maximum.

- Lets make the Wolverines Den a safe place for all, including staff.








