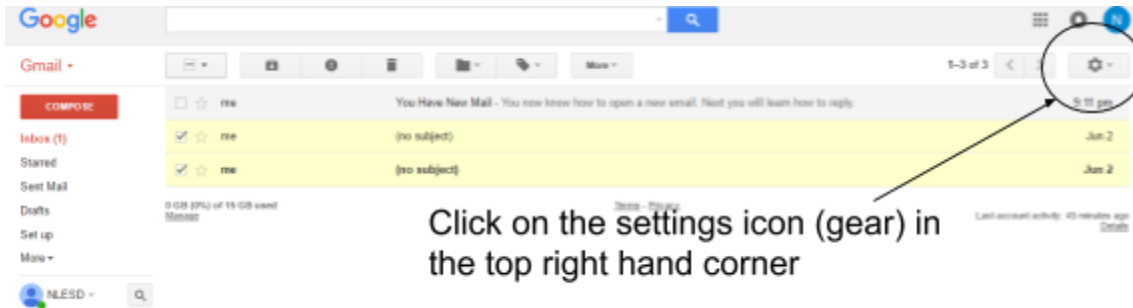
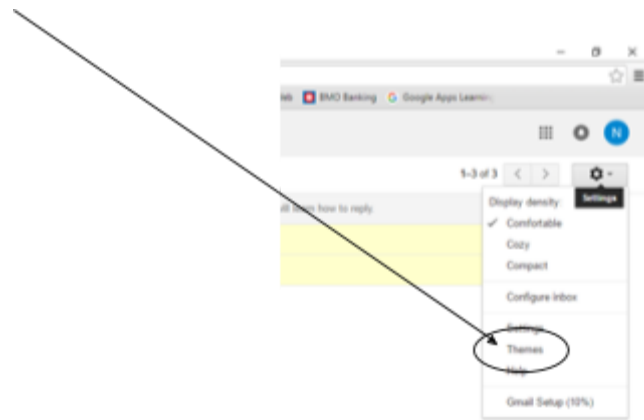


Setting a Background Theme in Gmail

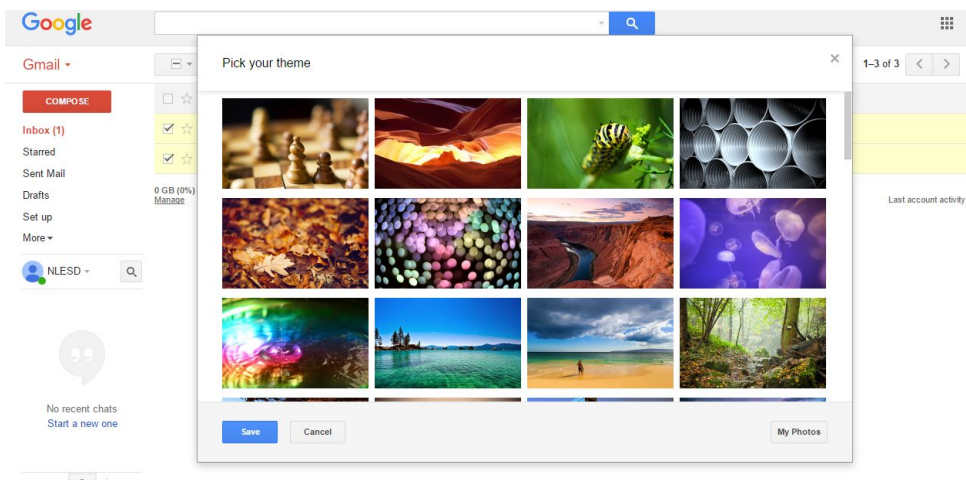
A theme allows you to customize the look of your Gmail account.



Select the “Themes” option.

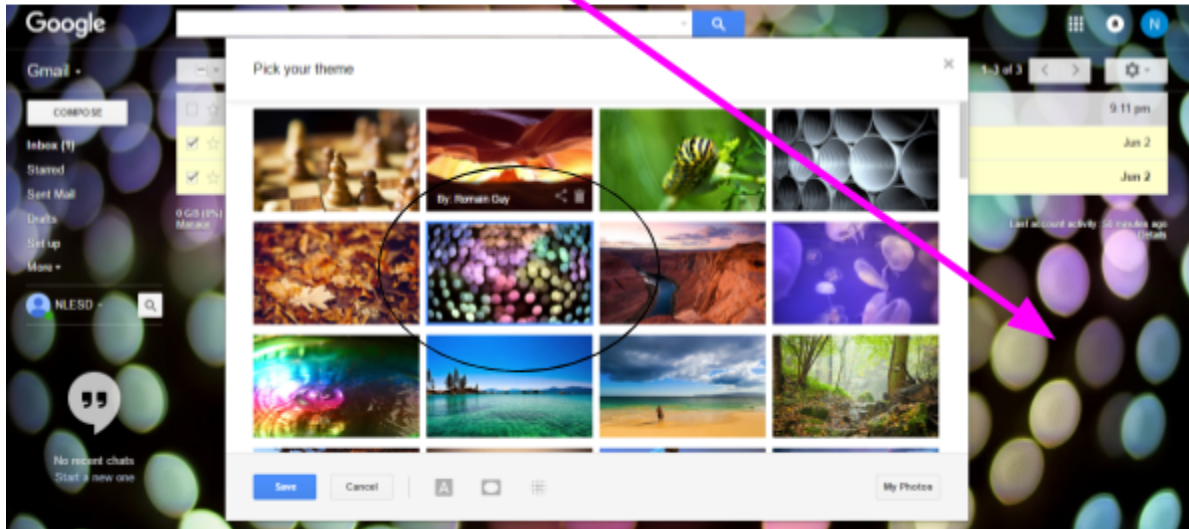


A page with a list of themes and sample pictures will load.

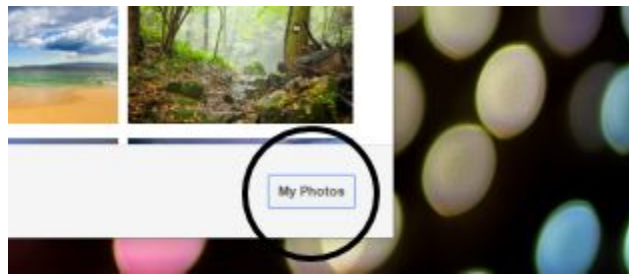




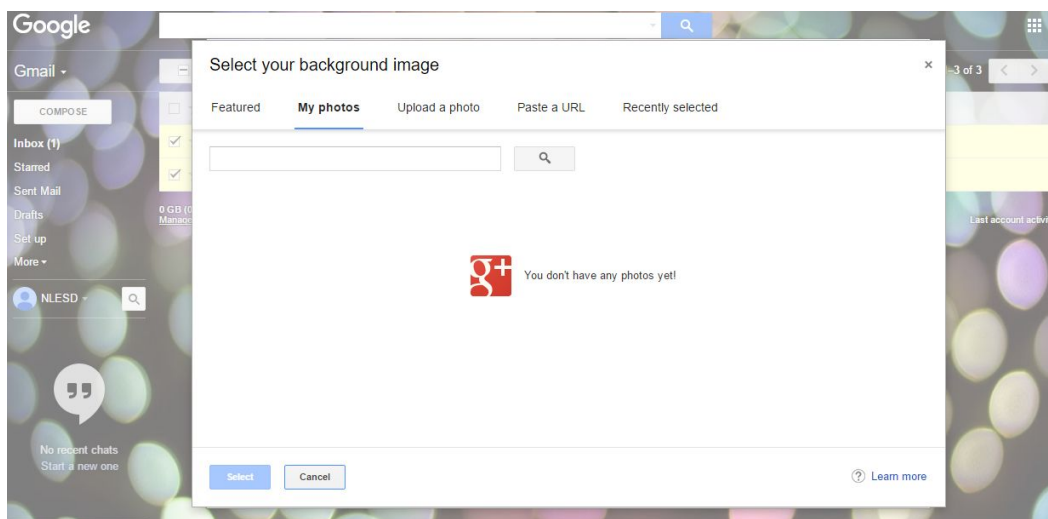
You can select a pre-loaded theme by clicking on it. It will appear immediately to preview.



If you prefer to use your own photo....you can select "My Photo" at the bottom of the window.



This feature allows you to add your own photo from various locations (i.e. computer, URL, etc.)
