

Pumpkin Ball

Preparation: Make a smiling pumpkin face on a large Omnikin ball. You will also need 20 - 30 dodge balls. Place the pumpkin ball in the center of the playing area and 2 smaller Omnikin balls on each side of the large Omnikin. The dodge balls should be placed on both volleyball 10ft lines.

Objective: Throwing accuracy - Throw the dodge balls at the "Pumpkins" in an attempt to get it them to roll across their opponents green line.

Procedure: Divide the class into two groups. Both groups should start with one hand touching the wall at each end of the gym. Students must touch the wall until the music begins. The object of the game is to move the pumpkin balls across your opponent's green line by throwing dodge balls at them. Students may not touch the "Great Pumpkins" or push them with a ball. If a player touches the ball the opposing team is awarded a point. Players may throw at the pumpkin ball only when they are behind their team's green line. Students MAY NOT throw from within the pumpkin ball area. They MAY, however, enter the pumpkin ball area to retrieve a ball, but must go back to their own side to throw. A group is awarded a point each time the pumpkin ball crosses the other team's line. Quickly set back up and begin another round.
