

Crab Soccer

- *Split class into four teams.
- *Each team will sit on one of the four sides of a square playing area.
- *Students need to number off.
- *Teacher will call a number. All of the students with that number assigned to them will crab walk to the middle area of the square. These students are trying to kick the Omniken ball over the heads of the other teams.
- *While this is occurring, the other teams' players are also in crab position on the sidelines and are playing defense, trying to keep the ball from going "out" on their sides.
- *Each time the ball goes over a team's heads, a "goal" is scored, and that team gets a point. The winning team has the LEAST amount of points by the end of the game.

Details

- *Once every number has been called, that "round" is over, and the teams will rotate sides.
- *A "game" is over and a winner is determined after all four teams have played all sides.
