ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS

The school district of residence is defined by RSA 193:12, 11.

All new resident students, accompanied by a parent or guardian, will register before opening day or before their first day of school.

Students entering school for the first time must have proof of physical examination, immunization records, or a waiver of immunization and proof of residency satisfactory to the District Administrator or his/her designee. A current New Hampshire driver's license showing a Monroe address will be valid proof of residency. In cases where there is a need to validate a student's legal residency, it will be done through the Parenting Plan established by Family Court. Proof of residency may be required at the beginning of each school year.

The District Administrator or designee will meet with new students and parents as needed to explain the school program and policies.
