3. Write a minimum of 6 annotations at least 2 sentences in length each to describe various parts of your drawing. Number these 1-6 on your paper.


Example

Knight
England, 1100 - 1500

2. The main armor of a knight was chain mail. These linked metal rings offered solid protection and were light enough to allow easy movement.

4. A knight's outer coat often showed the colors of his lord. This helped to identify the knights in battle.

5. Their swords were called broadswords. They were heavy, straight blades best used for stabbing.



1. There were multiple styles of helmets for knights but most were metal. Though they protected against sword cuts they left you with quite a headache if you were hit.

3. Knight's shields were metal and offered great protection. They often were painted with crosses to represent Christ.

5. Knights wore armor from head to toe. On their feet they wore greaves which were basically metal shoes.
