That money will go a long way towards sustaining this program. Just last night, I worked up the gumption to finally order a new professional bass trombone; a critical piece of equipment that we don't have. The one Josh uses in Jazz 1 is being borrowed from a local private teacher. Later this year, I plan on replacing a vibraphone that is simply too small for practical use in the classroom, and doesn't sound good enough for performances. Between the two quality instruments, we're looking at roughly \$8,000 after tax and shipping. The band maintains about 85 wind instruments for student use; not to mention the plethora of rousing percussion instruments and beaters. Due to our tight budget, we do not / cannot spend enough to adequately care for this inventory. Thank you for your support.
