

Saint Luke's Parish Youth Covenant

To create a Christian community during our events, the following guidelines are to be accepted for all Saint Luke's Youth gatherings, classes, and events. The success and enjoyment of our experience in Christian fellowship largely depends upon mutual respect and responsibility.

1. I will respect the human dignity of all people. I will not devalue anyone; such as name-calling or indicating to another that they are worthless. I will not strike or hit anyone; I will respect the personal space of others.
2. I understand that there will be designated times for me to use cell phones or electronics. I will not use these items during program/work-site time or they will be taken away and returned at the end of the event.
3. Consideration and respect for others is expected at all times. Listening and participating in group conversations, lights out, quiet times and worship or prayer times are a few examples of when to demonstrate your thoughtfulness and silence.
4. I will respect the sacred spaces we share, including the Church, Chapel, AYCC, Youth Room, and Saint Luke's campus.
5. I will not bring, use, or be under the influence of any drug including alcohol, tobacco, or over the counter stimulants. I will not bring or possess any form of weapon; including knives, firearms, or fireworks.
6. Sexual relations between youth and youth/adults or inappropriate displays of affection, or overly sexualized language will not be tolerated.

Participants who break any of these guidelines may be asked to leave. Parents, clergy, and youth leaders will be notified.
