General Roles:

Outreach & Partnership Lead

Contact hospitals, schools, community centers, and local organizations to build partnerships and help us distribute diabetes care kits. You'll also help recruit volunteers and spread awareness about our mission.

Social Media Coordinator

Create engaging Instagram, LinkedIn, and possibly TikTok content to promote Kits For Good, share updates, and grow our following. Great for someone who's creative, consistent, and knows how to connect with others online.

Kit Designer

Curate and visually organize the care kit layout. Help with sourcing items, packaging design, and ensuring kits are safe, useful, and visually appealing. A great role for someone with an eye for design and empathy.

Fundraising Assistant

Support crowdfunding efforts (like GoFundMe), apply for mini grants, and brainstorm low-cost, creative ways to raise money. Ideal for someone who enjoys planning and wants to learn nonprofit finance skills.
