- -the writing has to zing, pop off the page, stand out -creativity-the essay is 3 dimensional
- -a thoroughgoing consideration of the prompt,
- i.e.understanding of the **implied task at hand** of the prompt
- -control over conventions
- -variety of sentence structure
- -sophisticated use of language, such as word choice
- or figurative language -- do not confuse sophisticated with "big words"
- -the writer's personality, i.e the writing is expressive of you as a curious, smart, clever, interesting, tolerant, and open minded person ready to make an impact on the university community.
