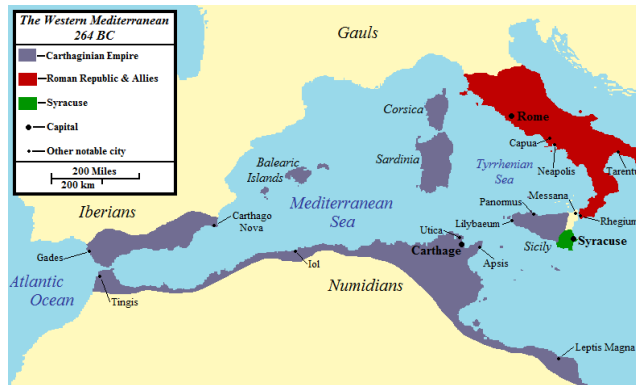


The Punic Wars
