## **Convention Delegate Spirit Rules**

- 1. All chapters attending State Convention are eligible to participate.
- 2. Judging will begin when recognized, before General Assembly II and before the Roman Banquet.
- 3. Participants must not shout or move in ways that could violate social distancing (lunging, jumping, squatting). Points will be taken away if this rule is violated.
- 4. There is to be no cheering outside of the designated spaces and times.
- 5. No props, noisemakers, or banners except for the purpose of roll call. Your school's banner (provided by the IJCL) must remain in its original location. If you cannot wear it, don't bring it.
- 6. A spirited roll call during General Assembly I is included in the contest. Groups will have 1.5 minutes to present an entertaining skit or song which will be judged on originality, delivery, creativity, and overall entertainment. Somewhere in the skit, each school must give the number of delegates and adults from their school present at the convention.
  - All delegates may participate in this roll call except current state officers, anyone running for state office, sponsors, chaperones, and former members.
- 7. Delegates will be judged on club/school shirts prior to General Assembly II and Roman costumes prior to the Roman Banquet.
- 8. Each year the executive board will appoint the judges.
