-> Stole his riffs -> Old manager that abused you is Pepito Ynescko

Chris->The Punisher -> White Knight -> Winchester-> Dumb baby

MISFORTUNES CONCERT

The Misfortunes, the hottest band in town are playing their new show.

The party is investigating the disappearance of the lead singer of the Misfortunes, the mono-named Barrymore. If any players are Barrymore fans and pass a difficult roll, they know that the songs of Barrymore are laced with occult significance.

Common themes include ill advised demonic bargains, the Bast cult of London, Oscar Wilde, and Egyptian mythology, as well as increasingly maudlin lyrics.

At the show the Misfortunes are premiering their new lead singer - Laurel Wreath. It is a secret show. Ask the players how they found out about it.

The club is partially full with incredibly rabid Misfortunes fans, although there are Barrymore fans everywhere.

The name of the club is The Crossroads. The bartender is Seamus Wilde, who an informed player might know is a vampire, medium difficulty.

They get some information about the Bast cult. She is the goddess of protection against contagious diseases and the moon.

Interviewing them, you can learn through some work that a shadowy government agency...

First scene will be at Concert

The Misfortunes -> Beatles // Ramones // Joy Division -> Missing lead singer

Andrew's Demon - > Eats Tongue of Liars, Feline -> Bast

Gino Demon -> Alligator except no face or something and two tails, like an alligator worm, constantly oozing a corrosive acid ->

Chris Demon -> Trickster Demon, Wants a cult of babies (he's the daddy) -> Loki
