1. Apply to SBCC

- You must apply to Santa Barbara City College.
- You may apply to SBCC online at <u>SBCC.edu</u>
- Please email <u>saalvarez4@pipeline.sbcc.edu</u> to get into the cohort.
- You must complete all tasks required by SBCC before you may enroll in courses.
 This includes, but is not limited to, Orientation, Assessment Testing and sending your transcripts

2. Register for Classes

- The Culinary Arts Department is set up to take specific courses during each semester. It is to your best interest to complete these courses as closely to the schedule as possible.
- You must be registered in, and/or have passed (C or better), CA 113 Hospitality
 Sanitation in order to enter any Lab/Kitchen courses. No exceptions!

3. Purchase personal equipment

 You are required to purchase your personal equipment: a Chef uniform, serving uniform and a knife kit. You will need to purchase these items at the SBCC Bookstore. Please check with the Campus bookstore for available items.
