Prerequisites

Completion of the 7th grade.

Course Materials

All materials will be provided through the online course.

Communication

All communication with your teacher will be through email. You will receive a Welcome email from the eSchool Office when your course is ready for you. You may email your teacher at any time with questions that you might have.

Drop Period

Within 15 days of the online registration, students may cancel enrollment and receive a reimbursement, as per the enrollment agreement. An amount of \$50 will be retained for administrative fees. Notification of cancellation must be received in writing in the eSchool office at the address below within the 15-day period. An email from the student's parent is acceptable if received in the eSchool office within the 15-day period. If students do not complete a course within 18 weeks, they will be dropped from the course and tuition will not be reimbursed. If students have not communicated with their eSchool teacher within five days of registration, or are not adhering to their schedule for completing and turning in course work, they may be dropped from the course and tuition will not be reimbursed.

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Completion Time

The expiration date of enrollment is always 18 weeks from the start date indicated on the welcome letter sent by the eSchool office. However, the student may complete a course in as few as six weeks. The student must communicate with the teacher on a regular basis. If students have not communicated with their eSchool teacher within five days of registration, or if they fail to maintain the schedule for completing and turning in assignments, or if students fail to complete the course within the allotted 18 weeks, they will be dropped from the course and tuition will not be reimbursed.

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Assessments

This course may include assignments, quizzes, tests, and projects. These assessments will allow students to show mastery of the concepts they have learned. Teachers may need to review coursework before allowing students to take a test. Students should contact their teacher to move forward.

Class Participation and Schedule

Every student will have a specific schedule for completing and submitting assignments and tests. Students are required to adhere to their schedule. Students must maintain consistent email communication with their teacher. Students must complete all assignments and activities throughout the course. Students who are not adhering to their course schedule, or students who are not maintaining the basic requirements of participation, such as maintaining email communication with their teacher, may be dropped from the course.
