Your course work next year will be to design a lamp which could be sold in a department store such as John Lewis. The lamp you design needs to be inspired by a particular design movement of the 20th century.

Your research task over the summer is to create two pages of research based on the design movement of your choice.

One A3 page needs to be research into the design movement, looking at the following points:

- Where it originated from
- Dates
- Examples of products/architecture that have been inspired by this movement
- Designers who are famous for using this design movement.

Your Second A3 research page needs to be a mood board looking at images and inspiration relating to your chosen design movement. An A3 mood board should have at least 30 images that could inspire you into a creative lamp design.
