## **Movie Madness**

What's your favorite movie? Why? Is there some award winning acting? Should the actors have won awards? Is there a scene in there that really speaks to you?? Can you get your hands on that scene? Turn back to the video. How did you do? How much was body language and how much was dialogue? Could you bring that sort of power to your writing with more body language and dialogue cues? Did you capture the essence of the scene? Show us the scene and tell up how you think you did. Don't forget to tell us the movie and about where the scene is in the movie. Let us know if you got it over the internet so we can go back and look at the scene if we want.
