

The College of Education at SUNY Fredonia requires proof of New York State teacher certification fingerprinting prior to participation in field-based courses for all programs leading to NYS certification. Many of our NYS public and private school partners require fingerprint clearance in order to complete field based courses/practicum hours. You are responsible for obtaining proof of NYS teacher certification fingerprinting. Follow the instructions below.

New York State Teacher Certification Fingerprinting

Follow these instructions to have your fingerprinting completed.

- IdentoGO completes all NYS teacher certification fingerprinting.
 Appointments are required. To schedule an appointment, please visit: https://uenroll.identogo.com/workflows/14ZGQT
- 14ZGQT is the code for the New York State Department of Education~
 Certification fingerprinting and is included in the link above
- Enter a zip code to select a location
- Have appropriate identification when going to your appointment

- There are many types of fingerprinting. If you have been fingerprinted previously, please contact the College of Education Office of Student Services at edu@fredonia.edu
