

The College of Education at SUNY Fredonia requires proof of New York State teacher certification fingerprinting prior to participation in field-based courses for all programs leading to NYS certification. Many of our NYS public and private school partners require fingerprint clearance in order to complete field based courses/practicum hours. You are responsible for obtaining proof of NYS teacher certification fingerprinting. Follow the instructions below.

### New York State Teacher Certification Fingerprinting

Follow these instructions to have your fingerprinting completed.

- Identogo completes all NYS teacher certification fingerprinting. Appointments are required. To schedule an appointment, please visit: <https://uenroll.identogo.com/workflows/14ZGQT>
- 14ZGQT is the code for the New York State Department of Education~ Certification fingerprinting and is included in the link above
- Enter a zip code to select a location
- Have appropriate identification when going to your appointment
