# What does Novice-Mid mean?


- I can understand the main idea in short, simple texts on familiar topics when I listen and read in Spanish.
- I can ask and answer questions in a conversation on familiar topics, using simple sentences.
- I can write or speak on familiar topics, using phrases and short, simple sentences.
- I can use my focus words to tell a comprehensible story.

### What will we do?

The way to become proficient in a language is through comprehensible input. My job is to give you compelling and understandable language. Yours is to listen with the intent to understand by giving me your eyes and ears all class and letting me know when I am unclear to you.

#### Grades

Homework and Culture will often be completed in class and be brief. Listening and Reading show comprehension, but they do not require students to produce the language themselves, so they are worth 15% each. Writing and Speaking require production of the language, so they will have the most impact on students' grades at 30% each.

Students will have one test in each of the categories at the end of each unit. Each category will be tested separately. All students who actively participate in daily instruction and complete their classwork and brief homework usually do very well on the test. If you want to do well on an assessment, you will need to practice, practice!

#### **Homework:**

Homework will give students the added repetition they need to better internalize the language structures that are taught during class time. Homework is PRACTICE and errors help us learn. Students earn points for having assignments completed to the best of their ability; they will not be marked down for errors on homework assignments. However, incomplete assignments will receive 0's until they are fully completed. Completing homework will definitely help students acquire the language much faster.
