**ESTABLISH State Honours &
CONFER Birthday List of Honours**

In the name of His Exalted Highness
BISHNU CHETRY, Rajpramukh of the state of Uttarakhand

ON THE AUSPICIOUS OCCASION of my 21st BIRTHDAY, AS the Rajpramukh of Uttarakhand, I am pleased to issue my Royal Decree:

ARTICLE I: TO Establish the Most Eminent Royal Family Order of Uttarakhand

1. That, the Most Eminent Royal Family Order of Uttarakhand shall be established as the highest dynastic and chivalric order of the state of Uttarakhand and shall be associated with the House of Chetry and be






granted by the Rajpramukh in his capacity as the head of state of Uttaranchal and the Head of the royal house.

2. The Royal Family Order shall be conferred for meritorious services to the state and the royal house.
3. The Royal Family Order shall be conferred in the single grade of Grand Knight or Grand Dame which shall be reserved exclusively for members of the Uttaranchali royal family, sovereign monarchs, and foreign heads of state and shall be restricted to 15 living recipients. All the recipients of the order shall bear the post-nominal letters of GKRO and GDRO.
4. The Rajpramukh shall be the Sovereign of the order, while the heir to the throne shall be its Grand Master until further orders.
5. The ribbon bar of the order shall be a yellow bar with two red horizontal bars.



ARTICLE II: TO Establish the Most Honourable Order of Uttaranchal

1. That, the Most Honourable Order of Uttaranchal shall be established as the second highest state order which shall be conferred for distinguished services towards the state.
2. The order shall be conferred in five distinct grades:
 - 1) Grand Knight/Dame (GKU/GDU); *restricted to 15 living recipients*
 - 2) Grand Companion (GCU)
 - 3) Commander (COU)
 - 4) Officer (OOU)
 - 5) Member (MOU)
3. The Rajpramukh shall be the Sovereign of the order, while the heir to the throne shall be its Grand Master until further orders.
