

Family and School Communication Policy
(approved 3/25/2014, revised 10/16/18; revised 1/22/24)

PSCS Teachers and Directors will provide regular and open communication via classroom/grade-level blog entries to our website, emails, weekly school-wide emails, and, on occasion, community-wide phone messages. The goal will be to remain environmentally-aware and limit the amount of printed communications the PSCS community receives. Inclement weather, emergency situations and all other urgent information will be communicated via a minimum of two modes of communication.

At Pioneer Springs, we encourage students to discuss issues related to their well-being with their parents. We prohibit school employees from not notifying parents about their child's mental, emotional, or physical health and well-being, including the request for a change of name or pronoun. Further, we do not encourage or take actions that have the effect of encouraging students to withhold information from their parents about their mental, emotional, or physical health or well-being.
