This shall be made in consultation with Ateneo SJC.

² **Regarding Anonymous Submissions:** Pursuant to [Article IX, Section 5.4.2.1 of the 2026 Revised Electoral Code](#), anonymous submissions shall undergo a preliminary evaluation by the Legal Affairs Sub-Department. Should probable cause be established, the Sub-Department shall initiate the case *motu proprio* and acquire exclusive jurisdiction over the matter, effectively becoming the formal complainant. Consequently, the original anonymous submitter shall have no legal standing to participate in the proceedings or appeal the final outcome.
