- •Any standing water, not described as OB water, is casual. •
- \*Distances below are from Udisc. Sign distances were ranged and take into account fairway obstacles.

**Hole 1: Par 3 / 4**

Blue: 325' / 458'

Red: 325' / 393'

White: 233' to B position, Par 3

OB: Creek and beyond

**Hole 2: Par 3 / 4**

Blue: 389' / 533'

Red: 313' / 510'

White: 193' to A position, Par 3

OB: None

**Hole 3: Par 3**

Blue: 331'

Red : 194'

White: 116'

OB: surrounded by water

**Hole 4: Par 3**

Blue: 325'

Red: 279'

White: 170'

OB: None

**Hole 5: Par 3**

Blue: 339' / 466'

Red: 287' / 415'

White: 142' to A position

OB: Walking path and beyond

**Hole 6: Par 3 / 4**

Blue: 404' / 471'

Red: 301' / 388'

White: 180' to A position

OB: Creek and beyond. Retention basin - play disc where it last crossed in bounds.

**Hole 7: Par 3 / 4**

Blue: 443' / 527'

Red: 370' / 438'

White: 194' to B position

OB: Surrounded by water (blue tee); Walking path and beyond

**Hole 8: Par 3**

Blue: 374' / 412'

Red: 301' / 342'

White: 148' to A position

OB: Creek and beyond

**Hole 9: Par 3**

Blue: 289' / 388'

Red: 199' / 318'

White: 207' to long A position

OB: Walking path and beyond; creek and beyond; road and beyond; inside fence behind basket

Mando: Discs must fly to the right of the tree marked mando.

Drop-Zone: Bricks marked drop-zone are on the right edge of the mando tree

**Hole 10: Par 3 / 3 / 4**

Blue: 279' / 367' / 500'

Red: 279' / 367' / 500'

White: 130' to the B position

OB: Inside the fence, surrounded by water

Mando: Any disc that goes over the fence during flight is considered to have missed the mando. Hitting the fence **is not** considered missing the mando.

Drop-zone: Bricks marked drop-zone are at the end of the fence.

**Hole 11: Par 3 / 4**

Blue: 344' / 502'

Red: 266' / 418'  
White: 155' to A position  
OB: Creek and beyond

**Hole 12: Par 3 / 3 / 4**

Blue: 349' / 354' / 468'  
Red: 284' / 286' / 400'  
White: 202' to the A position  
OB: Creek and beyond

**Hole 13: Par 3 / 3 / 4**

Blue: 395' / 486' / 571'  
Red: 262' / 353' / 437'  
White: 227' to the A position  
OB: Surrounded by water  
Mando: Discs must fly to the right of the mando tree  
Drop-zone: Red tee pad

**Hole 14: Par 3**

Blue: 314'  
Red: 275'  
White: 230'  
OB: None

**Hole 15: Par 3**

Blue: 277' / 341'  
Red: 232' / 296'  
White: 153' to A position  
OB: Creek and beyond before the bridge. Surrounded by water after the bridge. Outside yellow rope if playing position B

**Hole 16: Par 3**

Blue: 404'  
Red: 299'  
White: 127'  
OB: Right side marked by string. Play where last crossed in bounds.  
OB: A disc coming to rest in the retention basin will proceed to the designated drop-zone.  
Drop-zone: Red tee pad acts as the drop-zone from a tee shot thrown from the blue tee  
White tee pad acts as drop-zone from a tee shot thrown from the red tee

**Hole 17: Par 3**

Blue: 443'  
Red: 274'  
White: 167'

OB: Walking path and beyond; creek and beyond.  
*Any other standing water is casual.*

**Hole 18: Par 5**

Blue: 725'

Red: 538'

White: 323'

OB: Creek and beyond

*\*Note that the ditch in front of the basket may play OB when marked by the tournament or league director*

**Hole 19: Par 3 / 3 / 4**

Blue: 332' / 365' / 492'

Red: 261' / 294' / 421'

White: 144' to the B position

OB: Creek and beyond

Mando: Must cross to the right of the mando tree. Missed mando proceeds to bricks set along the creek

**Hole 20: Par 4**

Blue: 535'

Red: 416'

White: 174'

OB: Parking lot and road and beyond; Creek and beyond; Any disc landing inside the retention pond fence - play were last crossed in-bounds. DO NOT retrieve. A club member will work with the County to retrieve discs and get them back to owners.

Mando: From blue tee, must cross to the right of the mando tree. Missed mando results in a re-tee from the blue tee pad
