Why I Hate School: The Finale!

I. Background

This year's Why I Hate School video will be the last one I make for a couple of reasons: 1) I won't be in school anymore, as I will have graduated from high school in June 2025, and 2) I am now transgender.

- 1. Since I won't be in school anymore, I can't hate on it anymore! School and the negatives that come with it will be over with.
- 2. I am now transgender! That's a good thing for me, as I'm finally myself, however, it's not good for the series. I am the voice actor for Teddy and a few other characters. However, I plan on having Teddy stay as his current self while I transition, so I need to get these videos out ASAP to ensure I can still voice him as intended before my voice gets softer.

Teddy returns to the next (and last) installment of the Why I Hate School series, being season 4 (*The Finale*). Running since 2020, this series dives into the various things about school that I don't like, such as the classwork, the types of students and teachers, emergency drills such as lockdowns and fire and earthquake drills, the rules, and even some of the classes we have to take. This series takes a comedic and story approach to the school setting, centered around a teddy bear named Teddy that has to wake up every morning to go to the fun-taking academic facility known as school. He doesn't want to go, but his

parents force him to go as attending school is legally required by law. There, he will face some of the stuff that I've listed above, and by the end of it all, he will feel mentally drained, only to have to do the same thing the following day or week.

II. Lead-up

For season 1 (*The Original*) and season 2 (*2022 Edition*), I've taken a more storyline approach to the series, with season 1 being about online school because of the pandemic, and season 2 being about the return to regular in-person school. However, for season 3 (*2024 Edition*), I decided to switch things up and instead do a skit-style approach. For that video, I decided to do a skit about the different things that happen during school. I plan on doing that style again for season 4 (*The Finale*), which will be about the different types of students and teachers.

III. Intro

The video will open with Teddy on the school bus, seemingly rethinking his life choices before he goes through yet another day at school. At school, he sees his usual classmates and teacher (Mr. Winnie the Pooh), and the day begins.

IV. Different skits

1. Teachers' pets/nerds

Teachers' pets are the people who would do anything for the teacher (like turning off the lights, snitching, or asking for homework). Nerds are the people who are smart and ramble on about a single topic due to their expertise (like video games or math).

2. Class clowns

The people who entertain the class and make them laugh with their jokes (or give them an awkward stare if it wasn't funny).

3. Slacker/dumb kids

The slackers are the people who don't pay attention in class. The dumb kids somehow lack the intelligence to understand a concept or how something is done. They will keep asking people how to do something, just to still not know how to do it afterwards. Both types often receive bad grades in school.

4. Athletes/jocks

This one is self-explanatory. These are the people who are on a school's sports team, like basketball and soccer. Stereotypes suggest that these people are popular and shove nerds into lockers.

5. The gossiper

Always putting their noses in other people's business, like talking about rumors of another student.

6. The couple

These people are so in love with each other that they often feel the need to make sure everyone knows that they're both together through PDA (public display of affection). They will hug, kiss, hold hands, say sweet (but often cringeworthy) things to each other, sometimes give each other gifts, etc.

7. Menaces/bullies

Always causing trouble. Stealing things, getting into fights, picking on others, cheating on tests, creating a mess (often in the bathroom), etc.

8. Band kids (Redditors)

This name is confusing as it's not actually about *kids who are in band*, but rather the "Redditors." These people will make jokes or talk about unfunny/cringeworthy memes and "gamer" terms like *poggers*.

9. Smart kids

Just as smart as the nerd, but better. These people won't do outrageous things like ask the teacher for the homework, but rather help students out on their homework, assignments, or even tests by knowing all the answers, thanks to their intelligence.

10. Late kids

This is self-explanatory. These people will often show up to class late, often in the middle of a lesson, minutes after the bell rings. Depending on the school, they will have to leave the class and return with a tardy slip.

VI. Overview

The video will begin with a recap from season 3, then the usual intro similar to seasons 2 and 3 featuring the characters that appear in the video. Then, the intro, skits, and outro scenes will play out, and the video will end with a final message and the credits.
