## Supplies:

- Stamp Sets Growth Takes Time (161497)
- Card Stock Granny Apple Green (146990), Early Espresso (119686), Basic White (159276)
- Stamp Pads Early Espresso (147114)
- Miscellaneous Tailor Made Tags Dies (155563), Stampin' Blends Combo Pack in Granny Apple Green (154885), Crumb Cake (154882), Flirty Flamingo (154884) and Balmy Blue (154830), Rhinestone Basic Jewels (144220), Linen Thread (104199), Wink of Stella Clear Glitter Brush (141897), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

## Measurements:

- Granny Apple Green card base: 5 ½" x 8 ½", and score at 4 ¼" and folded in half, 2" x 3-3/4"
- Early Espresso: 3-1/2" x 5-1/2"
- Basic White: 3-1/4" x 5-1/2", 2" x 3-3/4", 2" x 1-1/2"
- Linen Thread: 30"

## Instructions:

- On Basic White cardstock, stamp three trees with Early Espresso, color in leaves with both Dark and Light Granny Apple Green Blends then color in trunk with Dark Crumb Cake Blends.
- 2. Stamp sentiment and seedling in Early Espresso on Basic White, die cut with tag die and color in with Blends. Die cut Granny Apple Green cardstock with same die. Adhere to back of white tag with Multipurpose Liquid Glue aligning so they're askew but so the holes are aligned as much as possible.
- 3. Stamp watering can with Early Espresso. Color in can with Dark and Light Flirty Flamingo Blends and water with Dark Balmy Blue. Add Wink of Stella onto heart and water. Fussy cut out.
- 4. Overlap Linen Thread so you have two equal strands, insert into tag hole, tie in bow, and trim ends.

- 5. With Multipurpose Liquid Glue adhere water part of watering can to front of tag. Affix Stampin' Dimensionals (5) to back of tag and watering can then attach to card front.
- 6. Color three rhinestones the Dark Granny Apple Green then add to card front.
