- c. OCLC is looking for partners who use WSILL, Tipasa, or ILLiad to provide input on the next phase of development. Two paths of engagement: Smart Fulfillment Configuration or API interviews.
- d. Questions/Comments:
 - i. Where to find information about the Z39.50 server address and port?
 - 1. In ILLiad, there is a Z39.50 tab in the Customization Manager next to the Notification Templates tab. If you choose your server, you can see the address and port info.
 - ii. Is this used through an API or an addon App? No
 - iii. This sounds similar to IDS Project's rulekit
- 4. (10 minutes) Helmer Award Update (Adebola)
 - a. RSF team applied for the award in October, based on information received from a survey related to optical character recognition (OCR).
 - b. The project was selected and awarded money to help improve use of OCR across the Alliance by purchasing software, limited hardware, and providing training.
 - c. Next steps will include gathering more information through an application process to find out what individuals need, and coordinating with institutions to ensure successful purchases of software/hardware.
 - d. Just got notified of the award, so we still need to finalize the process and timeline for everything. Stay tuned for more information!
