
DSLR FILM NOOB Podcast #72 Show notes:



Aputure has a new line of 1080p field monitors. The <u>VS-1 FineHD</u> and the <u>VS-2 FineHD</u> both sport a 1920x1080 7 inch screen and pretty much all of the features seen in the older VS-1, 2 and 3 models respectively. Pricing on the VS-1 appears to be "under \$200" and the VS-2 is expected to come in at under \$400.

That's a pretty decent prices for that kind of resolution in a lower price field monitor. Both appear to be sporting IPS panels with <u>very similar specs</u>.

FS5 1.1 firmware, 4K inside and out!

These got snatched up quick, seems like everyone has been talking about them this year.


