# Structure of the Division Track and Field

## **Entry:**

Students who have qualified for the Division Track and Field will be automatically entered into the event. [Click here](#) to confirm student entry details.

## **Location:**

Ballarat Regional Athletics Centre - York St, Golden Point, 3350.

## **Parking:**

There will be ample parking available, however some restrictions will be in place to ensure that students are able to move freely around the venue without risking safety. Please adhere to the signage and cones/bollard put in place. Please note that this area (including the streets surrounding the track) is usually enforced by parking officers. Please comply to the local parking regulations.

## **Venue:**

The track being used will be tidy upon the commencement of the competition. It would be helpful if all students ensure they pick up all of their rubbish and place it in the bins provided.

## **Structure of event:**

- Students racing in the 1500m must arrive and register by 9:15am.
- The event will commence at 9:30am.
- Please adhere to the event timeline.
- In the event where there may be a clash of events, always notify the staff at both events, please note track events need to be prioritised and completed at the scheduled time.

- There will be a \$5 participation fee for all individual athletes

## **Weather**

In the event of inclement weather please check the [SSV website](#) for up dates on cancellations or alterations to the event proceedings. Alerts will appear in red at the top of the Sovereign or Eureka home pages. Schools will not be individually notified. All correspondence in relation to this event can be found on the Greater Western Region Page. Click on the event in the calendar to access the event page.

## **Progression to the Region event:**

This event will include separate Eureka and Sovereign events, athletes will compete in their own division with students who place 1st or 2nd in any individual event and teams who place first in the relays progressing through to the [Greater Western Region event](#) on Friday the 10 October, 2025. This means two Sovereign and two Eureka athletes will progress for all individual events and one Sovereign and one Eureka team for each relay event.

**First Aid:**

Whilst a First Aid qualified official will be in place at the venue, competing schools are responsible for ensuring that reasonable provision is made for the treatment of injuries. All schools participating in SSV events are required to bring their own applicable first aid kit and Level 2 first aid trained adult (as per Department of Education requirements). Sports Tape MUST be supplied by the student/competing team. Strapping for injury prevention as required MUST be performed by the student/competing team. NB. The First Aid responder in attendance is NOT permitted to perform strapping.

**Nature of the tournament:**

Students are attending from in and around Ballarat to experience sport at a local level. All students are participating to enhance their own opportunities in life and to be a part of a team. In doing so we ask all students, spectators and staff to participate fairly and have fun.

**Code of Conduct:**

All SSV events follow the [Sporting Schools Victoria Codes of Conduct](#). Please ensure staff, students, coaches and supporters familiarise themselves with these prior to the event.

**Officials:**

Officials have been appointed for all events. Please respect their decisions and display good sportsmanship towards them. Under no circumstances should team officials or spectators approach event officials to advise them of incorrect decisions. The official process needs to be conducted under the dispute process.

**Disputes:**

Any disputes regarding decisions should be first directed to the event convenor. Only team managers are permitted to voice this dispute. This can either be conducted through written complaint or verbal complaint. Whichever the case the dispute will be discussed by the event convenor and the umpires in charge of that game. A decision will be reached immediately which we ask to be respected by all parties involved.

**Unsportsmanlike conduct**

In the event of unsportsmanlike conduct the following will occur (in accordance with SSV Code of Conduct Policy):

- *Players*- First instance- is given a warning, Second instance- be sent off and will take no further part in the present game, Third instance- be disqualified from partaking in the remainder of the carnival
- *Team Officials*- First instance- is given a warning, Second instance- is asked to leave the venue.
- *Spectators*- First instance- is given a warning, Second instance- is asked to leave the venue.
- *Disqualifying Teams*- In the event that a team has been given repeated warnings and still breach the unsportsmanlike conduct they will be disqualified from the competition and be stripped of all championship points. Also a letter will be drafted and sent to the SSV informing them of the situation.

**PLEASE NOTE:**

In the past we have had issues with children who are competing in more than one event who may experience a clash of events. We would advise that teachers are responsible for ensuring that children prioritise their track event and always ensure that they report to their field events prior to heading to track events and that they return to complete their field event immediately after their Track event has finished. In addition, the rules around high jump mean that the bar will not be lowered so a student who goes to a track event will be disadvantaged upon returning to this event (this may impact on which events children are selected into by schools/districts).

The organisers reserve the right to start any event prior to or later than the time shown on the program Athletes should be at the track at least 30 minutes prior to their event starting time. These times are only a guide.

A problem may arise for buses if children are involved in relay events. Please make appropriate arrangements in preparation for any possible delays.

Competitors are permitted to enter two individual events and one relay.
