

LAWLESS WORDS

This is your guide. Take out this piece of paper from the wine list (but hold onto the wine list!). Order a drink/ a nibble and make yourself comfortable.

Prepare your blank piece of paper and a pen.

Take a sip or a bite of your purchase and let it rest in your mouth for at least 10 seconds. Write down one single flavour that you sense.

From your personal perspective, describe one decorative feature of the environment that stands out to you using 3 words or less (eg. Metal Wine rack: Sturdy, austere, looming).

Describe a smell that lingers at the back of your nose above all other smells.

Flick through the wine list or the food menu and choose 5 words that catch your eye.

Tune into the song that is playing in the speakers right now and write down the first noun that you hear.

Cast your eye around the restaurant (you can go for a little walk if you like) and pick out one word that exists on an object.

Focus on a person that is with you in this space and create three imaginings about their character or private life (They own a burmese cat/ they are pretending to like the wine they are drinking, they have an itch on their right foot).

Now scan back on all that you've written.

Construct 3 sentences in the loose format of 'Adjective + Subject/Noun + Subject/Noun'.

Link the 3 sentences with a verb.

When you are finished please signal to me.

I will collect your words for a moment.

Ask for the bill.
