

In-Person Reading Tutoring Instructions for Middle School

Preparation: 5 Minutes Before you sit next to your tutee

- 1. Get an EPATT laptop or iPad device (laptop preferred)
- 2. Log in to your **EPATT** Zoom Account (use Google Credentials)
- 3. Start Zoom Meeting through your personal meeting room
- 4. Make sure your camera and microphone are both turned on and that you can be seen in the camera
- 5. Start recording to the Cloud Why? We are recording sessions for feedback and training purposes.
- 6. Begin screen sharing!
- 7. You are all ready to start working with your student!



What to do during your session:

- 1. Have your tutee log in to **their Clever Account** and Select Achieve3000
- 2. Choose article of interest or assigned article. Make sure it is an Article + Activity or a 5 Step Lesson
- 3. Pre-Reading Activities (Title, Location, Date, Vocabulary Words, Connections)
- 4. Read. Have your student READ ALOUD.
 - a. Have them pay attention to punctuation and read expressively.
 - b. Ask questions to gauge their comprehension of the material
 - c. Feel free to model reading a paragraph after they have especially if they are having a challenging time decoding the words.
- 5. If there are any extra resources with the article (like a video or map) feel free to explore them after you are done reading.
- 6. Discuss the article briefly. Then leave your student to take the quiz on their own. REMIND THEM they can refer back to the text and resources for any help they think they need. Encourage them to take their time, read thoroughly, and aim for a 100%! Then get up and walk away. Go get some water or take a bathroom break.
- 7. When your tutee is done, discuss the quiz results and missed questions. Go back and find the answers in the text.
- 8. Now if there is any time, left, have some fun with the lesson! (Lesson Crossword or further research on the topic or a project related to the reading)
- 9. Complete the EPATT Tutor Log before you leave the site.
