-At least 2 takes for each line done for the audition!

-This is a *paid casting call!* I'm willing to look at your commission prices if you're chosen for one of the rolls. *I'm hoping to pay per line, however I'm willing to work something out if you have no pre-established prices.*

We will discuss details for the recording of the official script if you're chosen!

You're welcome to try out for both characters!

All the details for lines to read and general voice descriptions are below! You're welcome to read all the audition lines or just a couple! You're also welcome to improv if the opportunity strikes!

Mid-range voice with an accent to it (Trans-Atlantic accent or an accent adjacent to that, perhaps a Boston or New York accent could work too.)
