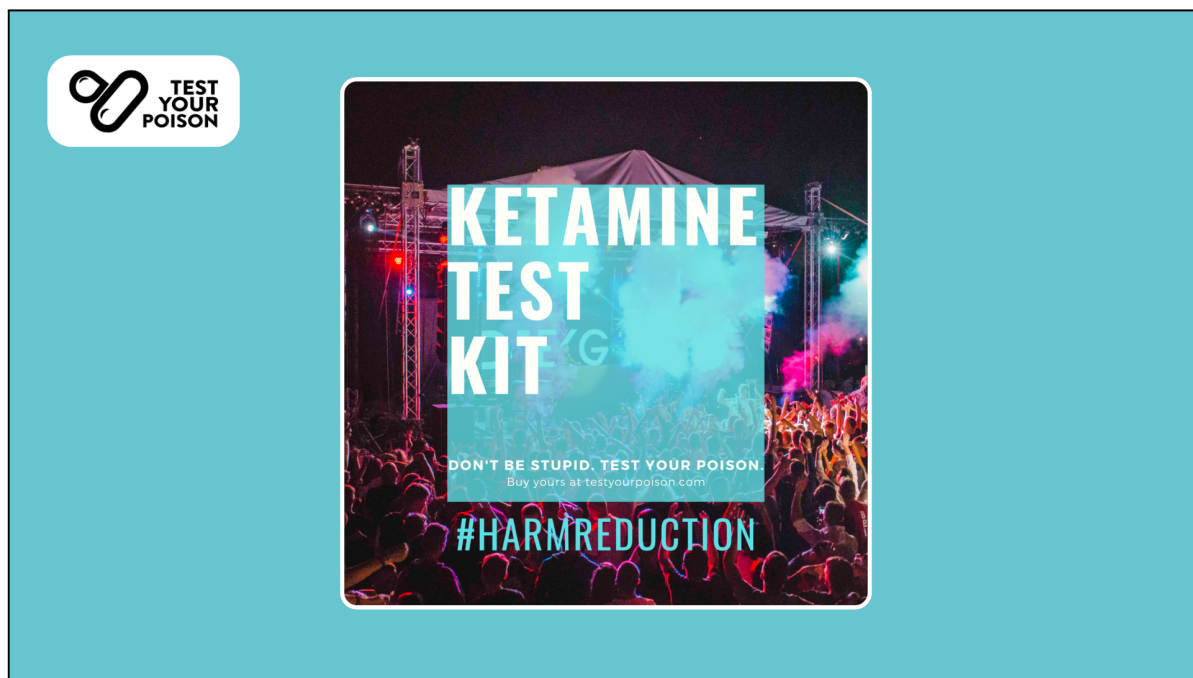


How To Ensure Drug Safety And Purity With Ketamine Test Kits?

Step-by-Step: How To Use a Ketamine Test Kit

1. Knock the unopened ampoule gently against a hard surface so any granules stuck to the walls fall to the bottom.
2. Break open the ampoule using the included plastic ampoule breaker.
3. Use the spatula to add approximately 20 mg of the sample into the ampoule. Break up any clumps.
4. Stir the solution for about 10 seconds using the spatula - but do NOT leave the spatula inside afterward.
5. Let the ampoule stand for around 5 minutes as the color develops.
6. Gently shake for 5 seconds to ensure an even color.
7. Compare the final color to the corresponding color bar printed on the ampoule.

If the color matches the ketamine result line → ketamine is present.

If there is no ketamine reaction → ketamine is not detected.
