

What is required for non-FIS families to enroll their children?

An email to real@fis.edu with the following:

Information required:

- Full name of parent / guardian
- Email address and telephone number of parent / guardian
- Full name of child(ren)
- Birth month and year of child(ren)
- Class(es) and weeks desired

Insurance Confirmation:

- Please note students who are not residents of Germany are not covered by our insurance. If your child(ren) is not a resident of Germany, please respond to this email confirming that you understand that you are responsible for accident / health insurance coverage during the Summer Discovery at FIS and include the name of your child(ren).
- Students who are residents in Germany taking part in our Summer Discovery fall under the Unfallkrankenkasse insurance. If your child(ren) is a resident of Germany, please send an email with the name of your child(ren) stating they are German residents.

Contact Telephone Number and Dietary/Medical Needs:

- Please be so kind as to provide us with a contact number in case of emergency as well as any medical, allergy and or dietary needs your child(ren) may have.

What grade level or division (Primary School, Elementary School, Upper School) should I sign my child up for when choosing program courses?

- All grade levels apply to your child's **current grade** in the 2025-2026 school year, regardless of if the division of grades is different at your child's relevant school.
- FIS splits grade level divisions as follows:
 - **Primary School: First Steps, Pre Primary, Primary, Grade 1*
 - **Please note that campers must be potty trained and able to use the restroom independently.*
 - *Elementary School: Grades 2, 3, 4 & 5*
 - *Upper School: Grades 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 & 12*

Is it possible to enroll my child for only part of the summer program?

- Yes, e.g. you can enroll your child for Weeks 2 and 4, without having to enroll them in the full 5 weeks of the offered Summer Discovery Program.

Is additional lunch booking mandatory when booking a full day camp?

- No, you are not required to book the lunch option along with a full day camp.
- If you choose not to book lunch, please make sure to send your child with a packed lunch.

Is lunch included if you book the afternoon Warriors Camp?

- Yes, lunch is included in our afternoon Warriors Camp.

Transportation

- Transportation is only offered from the FISW (Wiesbaden Campus) to the FISO (Oberursel Campus). There is no regular bus service.
